

# WELCOME TO NETOMI TRAIL

## Home of the New Scout



The road to Scouting Fun for a New Scout must be paved with a variety of outdoor skills that each New Scout can work on without feeling he is being graded on everything he does.

Netomi Trail is an opportunity to try his hand at knot tying, some basic outdoor cooking skills, learn a little first aid, learn to lash, and even take a nature hike. The big thing here is to have fun while trying.



The Netomi Trail schedule is flexible enough to allow the Scout to earn a Merit Badge or two and still have plenty of time to go to a couple of hours of outdoor skills training in those areas most interesting to him.

While in Netomi Trail, Scouts will have the opportunity to complete many of the requirements needed for the ranks of Tenderfoot, Second Class and First Class. Scoutmasters will receive a progress report on each Scout at the end of the week. It is up to the Scoutmaster to review the Scout's completion of requirements before signing them off.

We encourage any unit sending 5 or more Scouts/period to send an adult to support the activity. The following table shows the rank requirements in each of the daily sessions.

All of the Netomi Trail class periods require pre-registration. This is accomplished by having the Scout choose the class (e.g. NT1, NT2, NT3 or NT4) on the Personal Program form in period A, B, C, or G and then submitting it to the unit leader to be transferred to the Personal Program Troop Consolidation Form. These forms are located in the forms section of this leader guide.

\*These requirements will be touched on in class, but must be completed during Scout's free time.
